## Generating Resources & Equitable Access Together

January 12, 2026

St. Leonard's Society of Canada (SLSC), in partnership with Lifers' Liaison Group (LLG), are pleased to announce the launch of our new initiative: **inteGREAT (Generating Resources & Equitable Access Together)**, thanks to support from The Law Foundation of Ontario!

### What is the inteGREAT project about?

This project will create inteGREAT as a system navigation service within and beyond the federal prison system. It will bring different partners and strategies together to improve access to legal information, education, and resources. inteGREAT will enhance transparency, coordination, and accessibility by strengthening new and existing efforts and modernizing how information and navigation supports are delivered in prisons and the community.

### What is the goal?

Our goal is to advance access to justice by reducing systemic silos, improving collaboration, and empowering people to better understand their rights, responsibilities, and options. inteGREAT will address critical gaps in knowledge, communication, services, and digital equity through accessible tools that support informed decision-making and planning. By streamlining services and improving system navigation, inteGREAT will strengthen both individual and collective capacity to respond to evolving needs.

### What will we do?

inteGREAT will be built through a co-developed process with justice-involved people, community organizations, and government partners. The two-year project will have three main phases: 1) Identifying system gaps, strengths, and priority needs; 2) Co-developing solutions and tools; and, 3) Implementing and evaluating solutions. inteGREAT will be built as a scalable framework for system navigation.

### Who is the focus?

The project will start in **Ontario** by focusing on enhancing intersectoral capacity to improve access to justice for **people with indeterminate sentences** (i.e., life sentences and people designated as "Dangerous Offenders"), and the **professionals and organizations** who support their case management and community integration.

### What are the next steps?

Collaboration is the key to inteGREAT. Throughout the project, we will be engaging individuals and organizations in opportunities to share expertise, identify priorities, contribute resources, as well as co-design, implement, and evaluate solutions.
